"Oil is too important a commodity to leave to the Arabs." former US Secretary of State Henry Kissinger.

For OIL, Canada allied with the US played a role in the killing of more than 100,000 Iraqi people, during the Gulf War and the death of more than 1,200,000 Iraqi men, women and children, as a result of 12 years of crippling economic sanctions against Iraq.

For OIL, George W. Bush is planning a war that could kill up to 260,000 more people, according to the report "Collateral Damage." (www.medact.org).

For Peace and Justice we demand the implementation of UN Resolutions calling for an end to the Israeli occupation of the occupied territories.
